About Taking Responsibility

The Relationships Australia 'Taking Responsibility' program is designed for men who have hurt someone they love and are ready to take responsibility for their use of violent, controlling or abusive behaviours.

The program is for men who are keen to work towards relationships that are respectful and caring.

Taking Responsibility is a group program with individual support sessions.

Relationships Australia also provides support and courses for women and children to increase safety and reduce violence and abuse.



Taking Responsibility Course

The course provides an opportunity to begin the process of change by understanding thoughts, feelings and behaviours that support or destroy relationships.

Men can take responsibility by acknowledging their past actions, understanding what has led to their behaviour and accepting the consequences.

The Taking Responsibility course runs one night a week over 18 weeks. It also includes individual assessment, review and follow up meetings with a Relationships Australia NSW counsellor.

Former or current partners are contacted, supported and encouraged to attend courses or seminars for women who have experienced violent and/or abusive relationships.

This course is for men who have been abusive in relationships with female partners.

We have a skilled team of counsellors and group facilitators with qualifications and experience in Social Work, Psychology, Counselling, Group Work, Community Work, Mediation and Family Dispute Resolution.

No referral is required. Bookings are essential.
